Item 9: Other Events

Aboitiz Power Corporation (AboitizPower) has been informed by its affiliates, SN Aboitiz Power - Magat, Inc., (SNAP-Magat) and SN Aboitiz Power - Benguet, Inc. (SNAP-Benguet) that they have respectively signed Ancillary Services Procurement Agreements (ASPAs) with the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) for the provision of regulating and contingency reserves from the Magat and Ambuklao Hydroelectric Power Plants. The ASPAs cover firm contracted capacities for both regulating and contingency reserves at 155 MW for Magat and 95 MW for Ambuklao. The ASPAs are valid for three years from the issuance of a provisional or final approval by the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC).

Another affiliate, Therma Luzon, Inc. (TLI), also signed an ASPA with the NGCP covering both firm and non-firm contracted capacities for contingency reserve at 60 MW during off-peak and 60MW during peak hours, respectively. The TLI ASPA is valid for a period of five years from the date of approval by the ERC.
