

#### Gentlemen:

In connection with the issuance by APC of the 2017 Bonds and the 2014 Bonds (collectively the "Bonds"), we confirm that, with respect to the directorship of Mr. Romeo Bernardo in APC and in BPI Asset Management and Trust Corporation ("BPI AMTC" being the Trustee):

- Pursuant to his letter to PDEX dated 8 June 2017, Mr. Bernardo has consistently inhibited and recused himself from participating (or voting) in any corporate action or matter which has been approved or acted upon by the Board of Directors of BPI AMTC involving the Issuer and the Bonds.
- 2. Pursuant also to the same letter, Mr. Bernardo has undertaken that for as long as he is an independent director of the Issuer, he will continue to inhibit himself from participating and/or voting, and accordingly shall not participate and/or vote on any corporate action or matter related to the Issuer and/or the Bonds which is brought up for the approval of the Board of Directors of BPI AMTC, as well as the 2017 Bonds and all other future and subsequent bonds that may be issued by APC. Further, this undertaking shall be provided in the Prospectus of all such future and subsequent bonds issued by APC.
- 3. The foregoing representation and undertaking are also reflected in Section 3.16 of the Trust Agreement, which Trust Agreement is further referred to in the Prospectus dated 16 June 2017 in connection with the issuance of the 2017 Bonds (the "Prospectus"), and the disclosure thereof is not inconsistent with: (i) the Prospectus and (ii) the terms and conditions of the Underwriting Agreement and other documents related to the 2017 Bonds. To the best of our knowledge, we are not in breach of any provision of the Securities Regulation Code and its implementing rules and regulations on account of the foregoing representation and undertaking. Further, we shall inform PDEX of any notice from, finding by, or requirement of, the Securities and Exchange Commission with regard to the disclosures relative to and the interlocking directorship of Mr. Bernardo in APC and BPI AMTC, and the steps that will be

undertaken by APC and/or ourselves in connection therewith. We undertake to resolve any such finding or requirement in cooperation with PDEX and PDS Group to ensure order in the markets of our securities and the overall PDEX fixed income markets and in a manner protective of the investors.

- 4. This letter forms part of the Listing Agreement of APC dated 18 April 2017. The remedies available under the Listing Agreement shall apply in equal force to this letter and actions arising therefrom.
- 5. We also confirm that we are hereby authorizing the disclosure of this letter to the public through the customary means of disclosure.
- This letter is without prejudice to and will not preclude PDEX from exercising any right or remedy, or performing any act available to it, under relevant Philippine law, rules, and regulations in relation to the foregoing representation and undertaking.
- 7. We attest to the authority of the signatories hereto to execute this letter and bind our respective institutions to the tenor of this letter.
