#### **Item 9: Other Matters**

Aboitiz Power Corporation (Aboitiz Power or the "Company") is implementing a work-from-home arrangement to ensure the health and safety of its team members while continuing to serve its customers and other stakeholders. In addition, all Aboitiz Power power generation facilities and power distribution utilities are fully operational. Business continuity plans have been activated to ensure the adequate and reliable supply and distribution of electricity. The Company will continue to operate in accordance with the protocols and guidelines of the government's community quarantine.

To keep the Company's team members and facilities safe, the following have also been implemented:

- Safeguards and support in place for Mission Critical teams
- Restricted non-essential travels and travel declaration by all employees

- Implemented safety protocols with suppliers and business partners
- Restricted external access to offices and facilities, and strict gate screening for illness symptoms
- Optimized the use of digital tools and channels for internal and external meetings
- Cancellation of group events
- Regular disinfection and germ-proofing of facilities (buildings and company vehicles)
- Provisions of personal protective equipment (PPE) and other viral prevention items
- All team members, here and abroad, are constantly reminded of personal hygiene practices and precautionary measures, and are given regular updates by the Company's COVID-19 Technical Working Group.

The Company is focused on understanding the coronavirus' possible ramifications to its generation and distribution businesses. AboitizPower is making sure that the fuel supply chain for its plants continues to remain open, and supply of parts and services from outside the country continues through a number of options. The Company is also in constant discussions with its customers and other key stakeholders to understand their situation, and are also working together to minimize the impact of this pandemic in the context of the parties' power supply agreements. AboitizPower is enabling the organization to anticipate and react accordingly as the situation will require.
