ABOITIZ POWER CORPORATION'S DISCLOSURE **Legal Proceedings**

Subject of the Disclosure	:	Luzon Hydro Corporation (LHC), a wholly owned subsidiary of Aboitiz Power Corporation (AboitizPower), filed a petition to enjoin the Municipality of Alilem from auctioning the real properties located in Alilem, Ilocos Sur.
Background/Description of the Disclosure	:	LHC advised AboitizPower that it filed a Petition for Prohibition and Mandamus, with prayer for a Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, to enjoin the Municipality of Alilem from auctioning the real properties located in Alilem, Ilocos Sur. LHC received a notice of real property tax ("RPT") delinquency from the Office of the Municipal Treasurer of Alilem, Ilocos Sur seeking to collect a total of Php 446,029,609.46 in unpaid RPT and accrued penalties covering the period from 2002 to August 2019. The Municipal Treasurer then issued a notice of publication and auction sale covering the real properties of LHC, consisting of industrial machineries and buildings.

Principal Parties	:	Luzon Hydro Corporation (Petitioner); and Cristina G. Monderin, in her official capacity as the Municipal Treasurer of Alilem, Ilocos Sur; The Provincial Government of Ilocos Sur, Jocelyn Cuyo Foz, in her official capacity as the Officer-in-Charge (OIC), Provincial Treasurer of Ilocos Sur; and Imelda R. Ben, in her official capacity as the Provincial Assessor of Ilocos Sur (collectively, as the Respondents).
Nature and description of the legal proceedings	:	LHC filed the Petition for Prohibition and Mandamus with prayer for a Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, to challenge the correctness of the amount assessed as RPT delinquency and to prevent the auction sale of the assets covered by the Warrants of Levy issued by the Municipal Treasurer of Alilem. The action will seek the enforcement of the executive orders issued by the Office of the President directing the reduction of RPT on property, machinery and equipment actually and directly used by Independent Power Producers (IPPs) under Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) contracts (however denominated), and condoning related RPT interest and penalties. Prior to its receipt of Alilem's notice of RPT delinquency, LHC has a standing offer to the Provincial Government of Ilocos Sur that it is willing to pay RPT computed in accordance with the provisions of Executive Order No. 60, series of 2018 ("EO 60"). The tender of payment was rejected. EO 60 allows the reduction and condonation of real property taxes and penalties assessed on power generation facilities of IPPs under BOT contracts. The reduction and condonation cover all liabilities for real

		property tax, including any special levies accruing to the Special Education Fund for calendar year (CY) 2017 and prior years. In addition, the Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management Corporation (PSALM) issued a letter to the Municipality of Alilem urging it to reconsider the auction of the levied assets, in consideration of the ownership rights and interest of the government (through PSALM) over the levied assets. On August 13, 2019, the President of the Philippines issued Executive Order No. 88, series of 2019, essentially reiterating the terms under EO 60 and confirming the reduction of the IPPs RPT obligations for all years up to 2018.
Effect (s) on the Issuer's business or operations, if any	:	There is no material impact to the business or operations of AboitizPower.
Other relevant Information	:	Incorporated on September 14, 1994, LHC owns, operates and manages the 70-MW Bakun AC run-of-river hydropower plant located in Amilongan, Alilem, Ilocos Sur. The plant was constructed and operated under the government's BOT scheme. As such, the 254 GWh of energy produced by the Bakun AC Hydro Plant annually, is delivered and taken up by NPC pursuant to a Power Purchase Agreement ("Bakun PPA") and dispatched to the Luzon Grid through the 230- kV Bauang-Bakun transmission line of NGCP. Under the terms of the Bakun PPA, all of the electricity generated by the Bakun AC Hydro Plant is purchased by NPC for a period of 25 years beginning February 2001. The Bakun PPA also requires LHC to transfer the Bakun AC Hydro Plant to NPC in February 2026, free from liens and without the payment of any compensation by NPC.
