

## NOTICE OF HEARING

On 27 September 2021, Cell Power Energy Corporation (CPEC) filed before the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) an Application dated 16 September 2021, entitled **“In the Matter of the Application for Authority to Develop, Own and/or Operate Dedicated Point-To-Point Limited Transmission Facilities to Connect the ±20 MW Bay Battery Energy Storage System to the Luzon Grid via the 69kV Bay Substation of the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines, With Prayer for Provisional Authority and Confidential Treatment of Information,”** docketed as **ERC Case No. 2021-028 MC**.

The Application was filed to comply with the requirements of Republic Act No. 9136, also known as the *Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2001* (EPIRA), its Implementing Rules and Regulations, as well as the relevant rules and regulations of the ERC.
